


Qaqortukulooq, Hvalsey 60.828660° N, -45.783157° E UNESCO World Heritage Protected Site





GUIDELINES FOR VISITORS

- Landings on the beach and along the shore at Qagortukuloog are strictly prohibited. All tender boats and zodiacs must land and disembark passengers at the pier.
- Larger groups of visitors should be accompanied by a qualified guide and always stay on the designated path to avoid trampling the vegetation.
- Stay at least 2 meters (6 feet) from the edge of ruins and never walk, sit, climb or stand on the walls of the church or any other ruins at Qaqortukulooq.
- Do not litter and take all rubbish with you when you leave. Do not use the site as a toilet.
- Never pick up or move an objects at the site. This includes stones, bones, plants and flowers. Leave everything undisturbed and never build cairns or stack stones at the site or anywhere else in Greenland.

DIFFICULTY LEVEL:

MEDIUM

The paths at Qaqortuqlooq have inclines and uneven terrain. The ground can be muddy and wet in some areas so be sure to wear appropriate footwear.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION:

- The vegetation at Qaqortukulooq is very fragile and can easily tear-always stay on the designated path.
- There are no restroom facilities at Qaqortukulooq.
- Follow the 'Leave No Trace' principles. Qagortukuloog requires visitors to pack out all trash. This includes organic waste such as apple cores and banana peels.
- It is permitted to enter the church, but please stay clear of the walls and never touch or move any stones.
